





Guidance for the ARC (Admissions and Release Committee- IEP team)

- The Guidance for ARCs on Participation Decisions for the Kentucky Alternate Assessment provides instructions and examples for Admissions and Release Committee (ARC) members to use when discussing and documenting alternate assessment participation.
- The KY Alternate Assessment Participation Guidelines Documentation Form is a form that ARCs use to make decisions about whether a student is eligible to participate in the Alternate Assessment. This form also includes a way to indicate the evidence that was used in making decisions and the considerations that should not be the basis of making decisions.
- The Parent Guide to the Alternate Assessment (Guia Para Padres Alterno K-PREP Spanish version) must be provided to the parent/guardian and provides important terms to know and frequently asked questions.
- The Alternate Assessment Participation Guidelines Record Review Document is to promote a consistent standard for districts to use when collecting and reviewing documentation of students eligible to participate in the state alternate assessments.
- The Questions and Answers Related to Grade 14 Studentsis nonregulatory guidance intended to provide frequently asked questions and answers related to students enrolled in grade 14 as referenced in the Data Standard Special Education Processes page.




